Flint Hills Resources Update

- FHR environmental, safety and community updates
 - Process Safety – no incidents
 - Personal Safety – no recordables
 - Environmental
 - Wescott flare event – power failure
 - H2 plant trip - flared
 - MPCA site audit – excellent audit, no findings. Additionally FHR demonstrated new technology for ultra-low level hydrocarbon detection, which generated positive excitement from the MPCA for the direction FHR is heading.
 - USCG unannounced drill – 'excellent' rating.
